WHY SUPPORT US?

- In October 2018, the *Indianapolis Star* recognized us among the <u>Top Performing Schools</u> in the State. Some of the highlights:
 - All schools routinely test in the top 5% in the state and consistently receive an A rating.
 - o Ranked #5 in Top Indiana School Districts for combined Math and ELA scores.
 - St. Mary Cathedral (grades 3-8) and Central Catholic (grade 10) are ranked #1 in Greater Lafayette in the area for combined Math and ELA scores.
 - College attendance among CC graduates is the highest in Tippecanoe County over the past five years.
- LCSS serves a diverse community. 57% of families receive some form of student aid based upon financial need, 23% of student body comprised of underrepresented minorities, and 18% qualify for free & reduced lunch.
- LCSS is a Christ-centered, faith-filled environment with 100% student participation in Christ-centered services, sacraments and retreats.
- LCSS encourages strong parental involvement and support.
- LCSS holds high academic standards and expectations.
- LCSS's community is dedicated and loyal to the schools and activities.

WHAT IS OUR HISTORY?

Catholic education in Greater Lafayette began in the early 1850's when the Sisters of Providence opened St. Martha and Mary School. During this period there was a large migration of Catholics to the area. In 1856 St. Boniface School opened, 1896 St. Lawrence School opened, 1923 St. Ann School opened, and 1928 St. Francis High School for girls opened. In 1956 the first lay teacher was hired and in 1957 Central Catholic was constructed for \$2.1 Million (>\$17M in today's \$). In 1956 and 1968 St. Francis High School and St. Ann School closed respectively. Due to low enrollment and financial issues Central Catholic was temporarily closed in 1990. After broad community support, Central Catholic reopened with a reaffirmed Catholic identity, tuition assistance fund established and consolidated financials across all four existing schools. In 1993 the governance structure established the "Lafayette Catholic School System." In 2006, the Catholic schools launched its first capital campaign in over 50 years. The primary focus was upgrading heating, cooling, electrical and plumbing, while adding a Chapel, new front entrance and science labs at CC. The same year enrollment in the Catholic schools started to grow after 34 years of decline. In 2012, LCSS amended its constitution and governance structure, and adds an Executive Director position to oversee operations. In 2014, CC launches its second capital campaign and raises roughly \$2.6 million for athletic infrastructure improvements. From 2011 to today, enrollment grows approximately 23% to over 1,100 students and diversity within the system increases nearly 600%.



On June 9, 2014 and January 16, 2015, the Board of Trustees, Board of Directors, along with the Principals from all four schools, and LCSS administration met for two full-day retreats to outline the parameters of a new Master Plan for Growth for the Lafayette Catholic School System. The group evaluated local demographic data, parish data, and trends in both private and public schools to develop a long term vision for our schools that met the following criteria:

- Flexibility: A flexible plan that can adapt to changing needs of the school system.
- Parish Identity: Maintain a connection to our six local parishes.
- Physical Infrastructure: Retire or update decaying infrastructure.
- Preschool: Invest in early childhood education and infrastructure.
- Ongoing Planning: Work closely with diocese on parish master planning efforts.

This effort has culminated into Vision 2030: A 15-year vision for physical facilities that accommodates the growth of up to 450 K-12 students and up to 300 Preschool and Daycare children.
